

Surprise Valley Joint Unified School District iPad Contract Agreement 2017-2018

As the Parent/Guardian of the above-named student (hereafter referred to as "Student") who is enrolled at Surprise Valley Joint Unified School District (hereafter referred to as "SVJUSD" or "Surprise Valley"), I acknowledge that SVJUSD requires all 4th and 5th grade students to obtain an iPad for class use, and for grades 6th-12th offers the option to check out an iPad, owned by SVJUSD, free of charge except as provided below, for use during the school year if the student does not own their own iPad. I am entering into this agreement on my behalf for the benefit of the Student and I hereby assume responsibility for communicating the terms of this agreement to the Student.

This device is for the purpose of conducting school work/school business during school hours or while working on school-related projects. However, personal use of the device is permitted at other times, within the limitations of this contract, and within any other standards of conduct that SVJUSD requires, such as, but not limited to, the standards found in the SVES and SVHS Student Handbooks. At all times, users will be held accountable for compliance with the iPad Acceptable Usage Policy.

iPads are available for check-out only to parents/guardians who have signed this iPad Contract Agreement for the 2017-2018 school year. All iPads owned by SVJUSD must be returned immediately if the student's enrollment at SVJUSD is withdrawn at any time during the school year. If the iPad is not surrendered at the time of the student's un-enrollment, the iPad will be considered stolen and reported with law enforcement as such.

SOFTWARE

I also acknowledge that the iPad may contain pre-installed apps which are the property of SVJUSD, and that such apps are downloaded through Surprise Valley JUSD Apple ID. I understand that students also have the flexibility to install apps through their personal Apple ID, so long as the app is being used in accordance with Acceptable Use Policy and the school rules at SVJUSD.

HARDWARE

I understand that the iPad comes with a protective case that is to remain on the iPad at all times. This case is not to be removed or replaced unless the case is surrendered to the principal and he approves the new case. Students may not remove the case for any reason. It is expected that the iPad will be returned in the same condition as when it was issued. The iPad screen is to be kept free of scratches or other permanent damage. If damage occurs, the iPad must be brought to your child's teacher or principal and an iPad Damage Report must be filed within 48 hours. The form is available either from the classroom teacher or the principal. Please note: even if an iPad is eligible for a warranty repair through Apple, if there is any damage to the iPad, the cost of the Apple Care (\$49) will have to be paid before the warranty repair will be made. There is a 3 time use of Apple Care, afterwards the full cost of the repair will be paid by the parent/guardian. Extended delays will result in a charge to the Student's account for the replacement cost of the iPad and its accessories. **Students/parents/guardians will be responsible for all repair costs or replacements.**

LICENSE TO USE

I acknowledge that I am responsible for advising the Student to operate the iPad properly and to be responsible for its basic care and maintenance. I shall also advise the Student to be responsible for adhering to all applicable copyright and software license agreements that limit downloading of media and software that has not been legally acquired. Content (photos or otherwise) containing evidence of pornographic nature or illegal behavior will result in surrender to local law enforcement for investigation.

SVES Wi-Fi Security

I understand and acknowledge that Surprise Valley JUSD has a secure Wi-Fi network on campus that is designed to prevent students from accessing inappropriate internet content. However, SVJUSD cannot provide this security once the iPad is off-campus. SVJUSD iPads are Wi-Fi only, and can only access the internet if connected to a Wi-Fi network. I further acknowledge that many vendors provide free Wi-Fi services, such as Surprise Cafe!, *Starbucks* and *McDonalds* and some public libraries, and SVJUSD cannot provide security relating to or limiting access at such locations.

END OF YEAR

As property of Surprise Valley Joint Unified School District, the iPad must be returned by the Parent/Guardian or Student in the same condition in which it was received, no later than the end of the last day of school. Any damage, including, but not limited to, scratches, cracks, or dents will need to be reported via an iPad Damage Report at that time. Grades, transcripts, and diplomas will be held until the iPad is satisfactorily returned, and all claims are cleared.

POLICY CHANGES

SVJUSD reserves the right to update this policy at any time. Any changes to this policy will be distributed through the normal communication channels to be signed by the Parent/Guardian.
